### **Our vision**

Our vision is for all young people to enjoy their lives, reach their full potential and make a good transition to adulthood. They should be able to achieve their ambitions, develop positive relationships and make worthwhile contributions to their communities.

We want to help councils to work across their departments and with their partners to support all young people to do this, enabling access to both universal services and targeted support through safe spaces and activities that young people need, want and value.

## What we want from government

- A portion of NCS funding given directly to local authorities
- NCS to work closely with local authorities
- Investment in early help and preventative services
- Funding to support measurement of outcomes and to develop a wider evidence base
