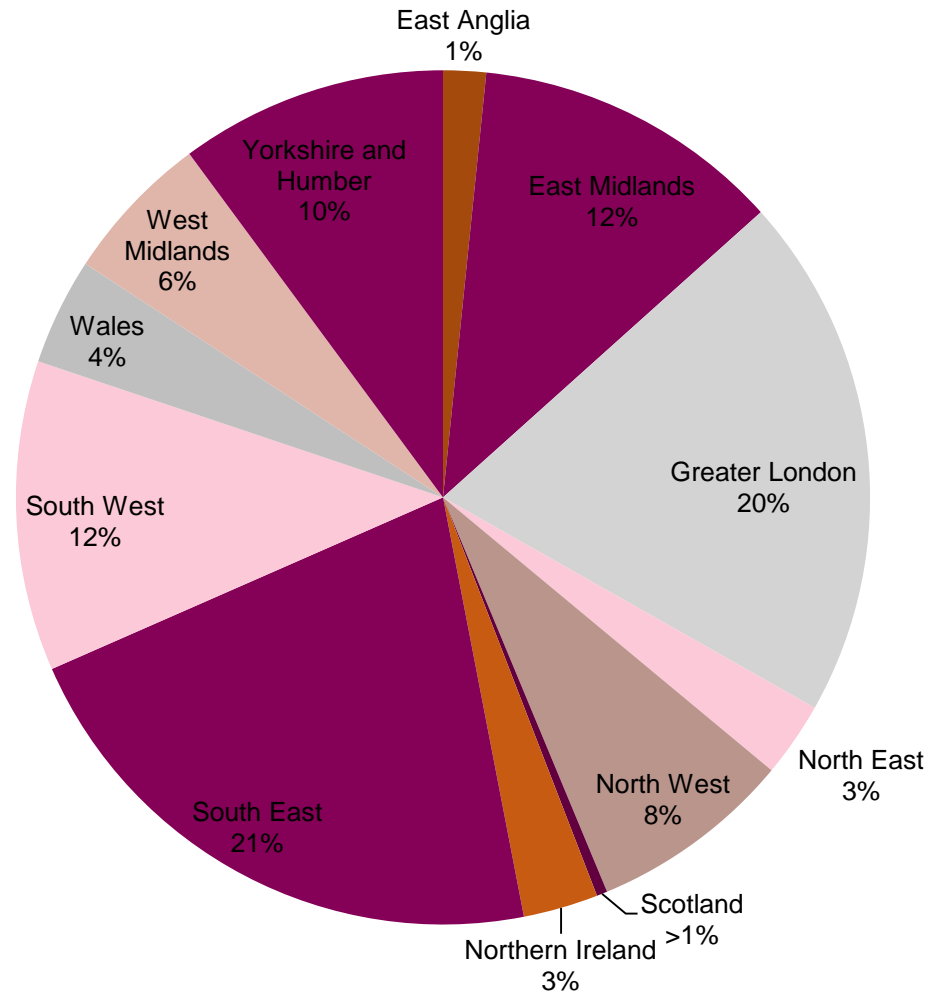

- Only those dynamic purchasing systems that are still active are listed, and the total number analysed is 242
- Data was gathered on the purchasing authority/party, the value, the length, the category of the services, and the sourcing platform used for the DPS

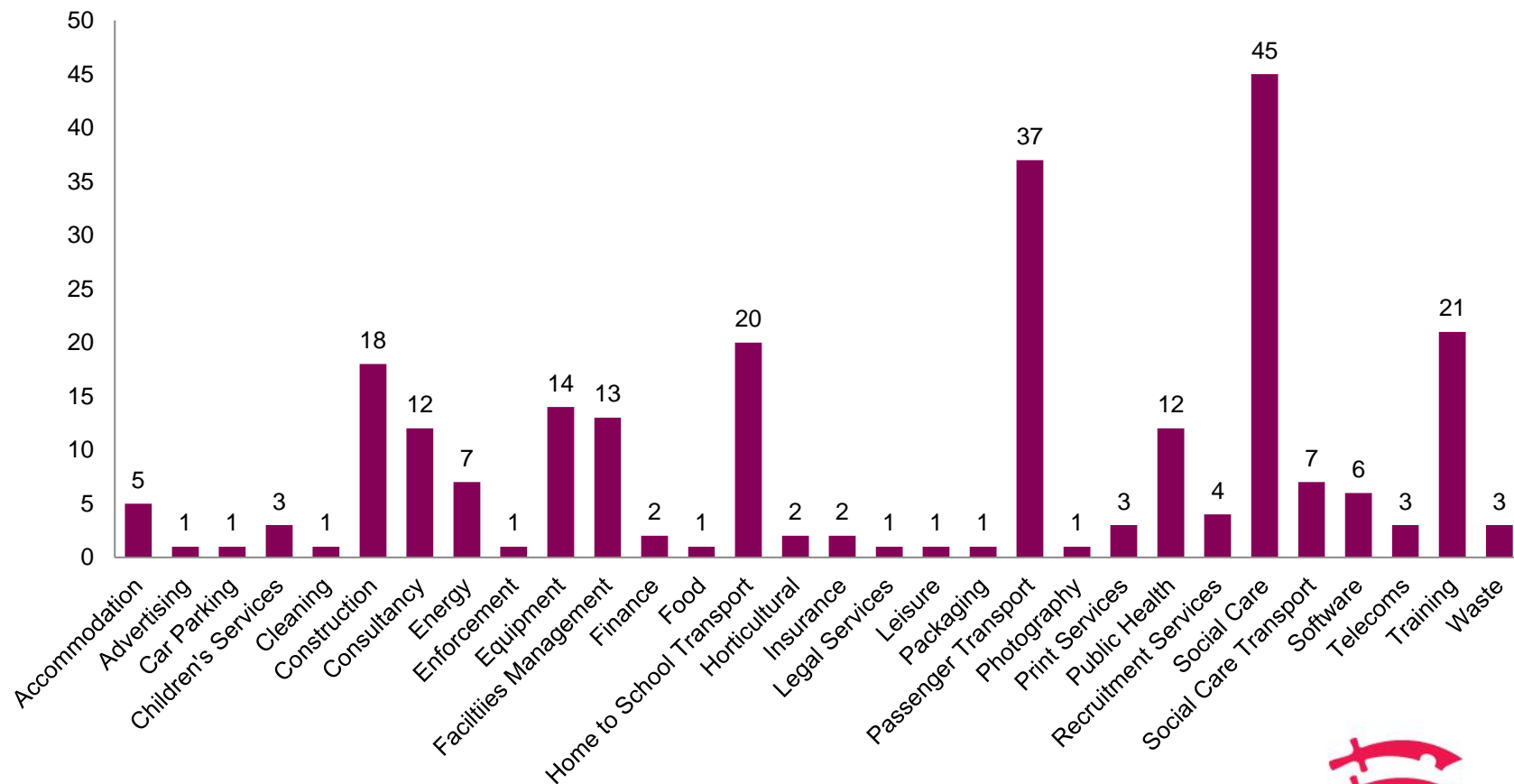
DPS by Region

The region of the originating authority for each DPS was analysed and the data has been included in the pie chart below to show the percentage of dynamic purchasing systems created by geographical area.



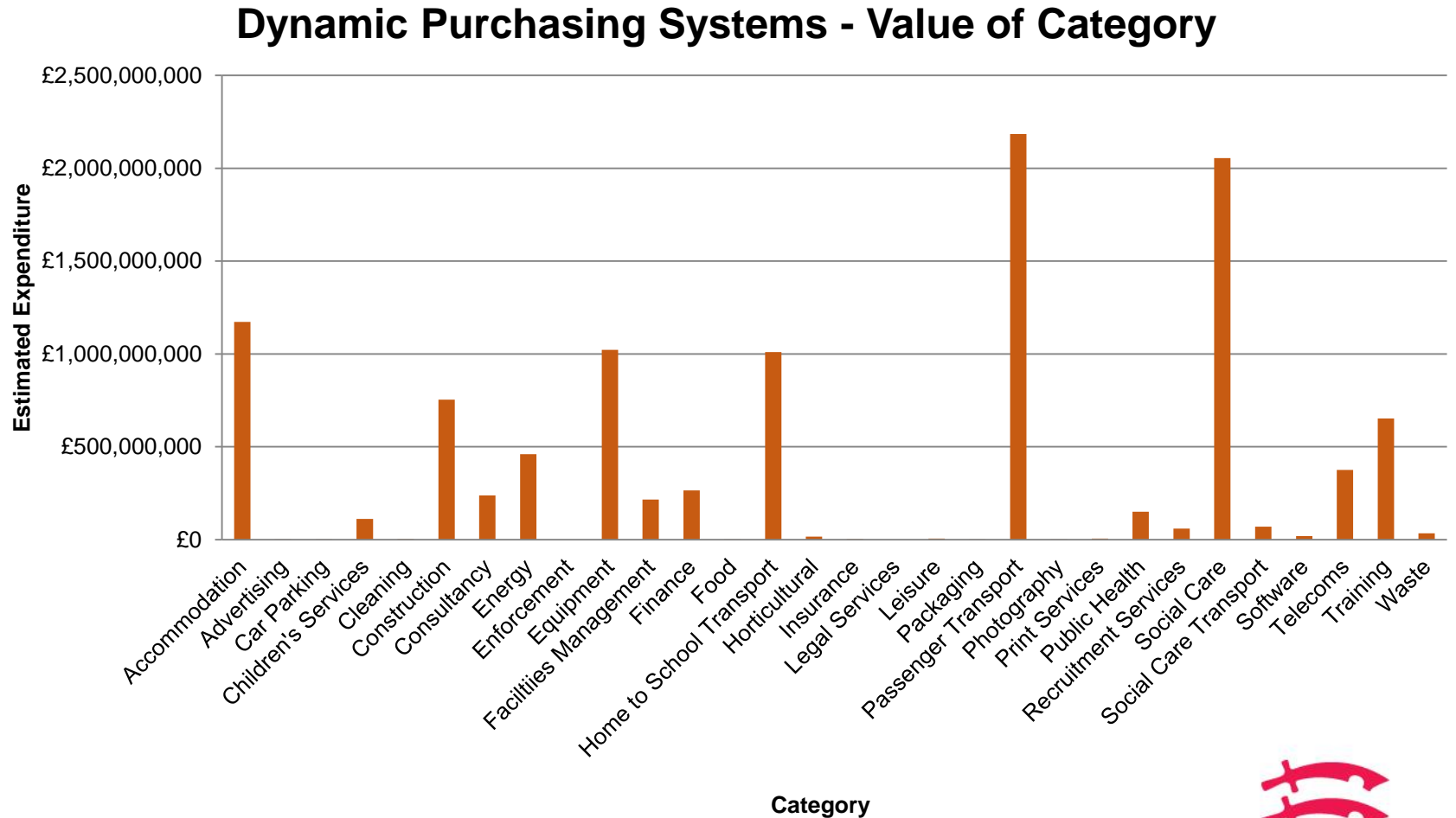
DPS by Category

The dynamic purchasing systems were broken down into categories of spend, and the number of active systems in each category is listed below:



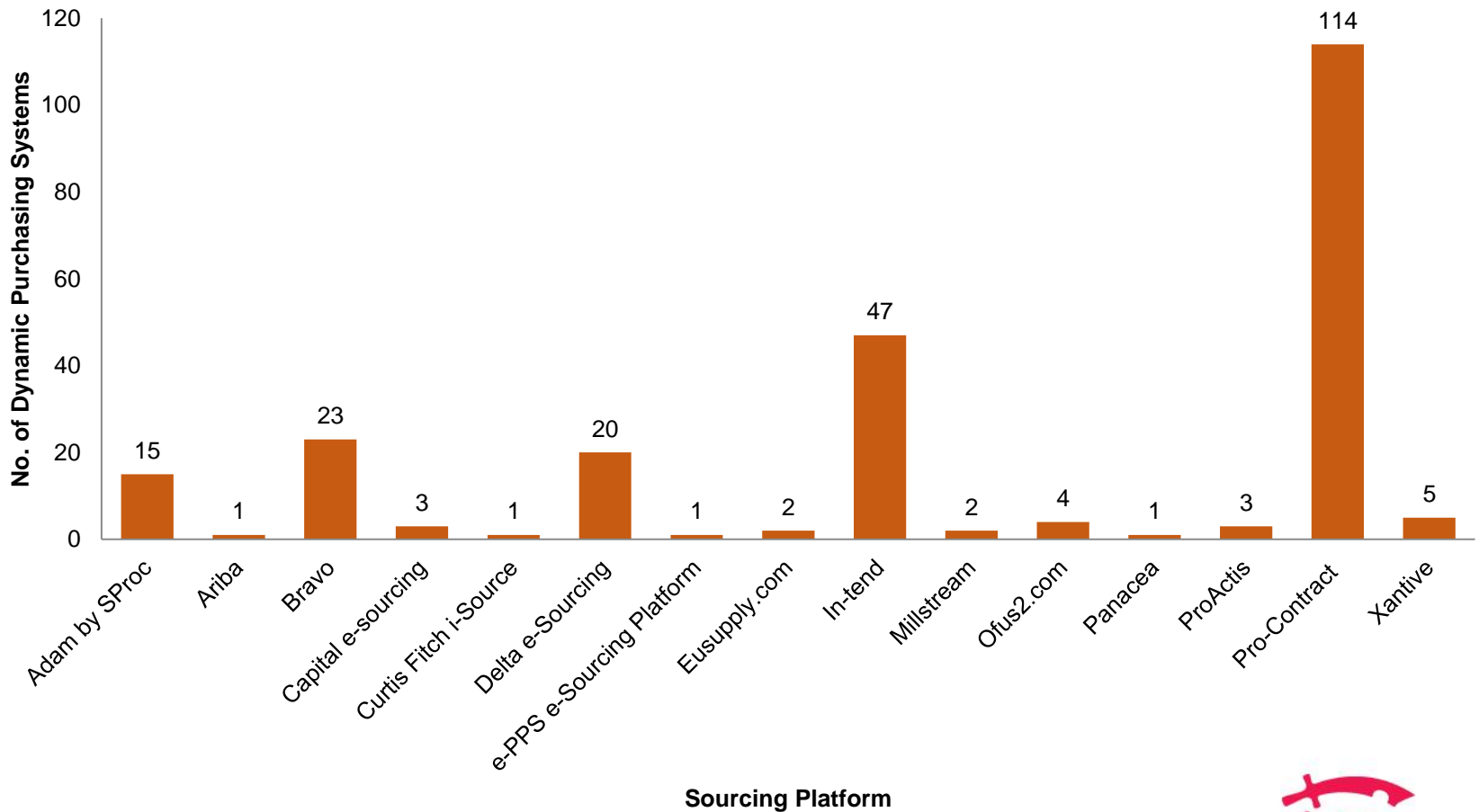
DPS by Category

The sourcing platforms used for the dynamic purchasing systems was recorded and broken down into the following chart:

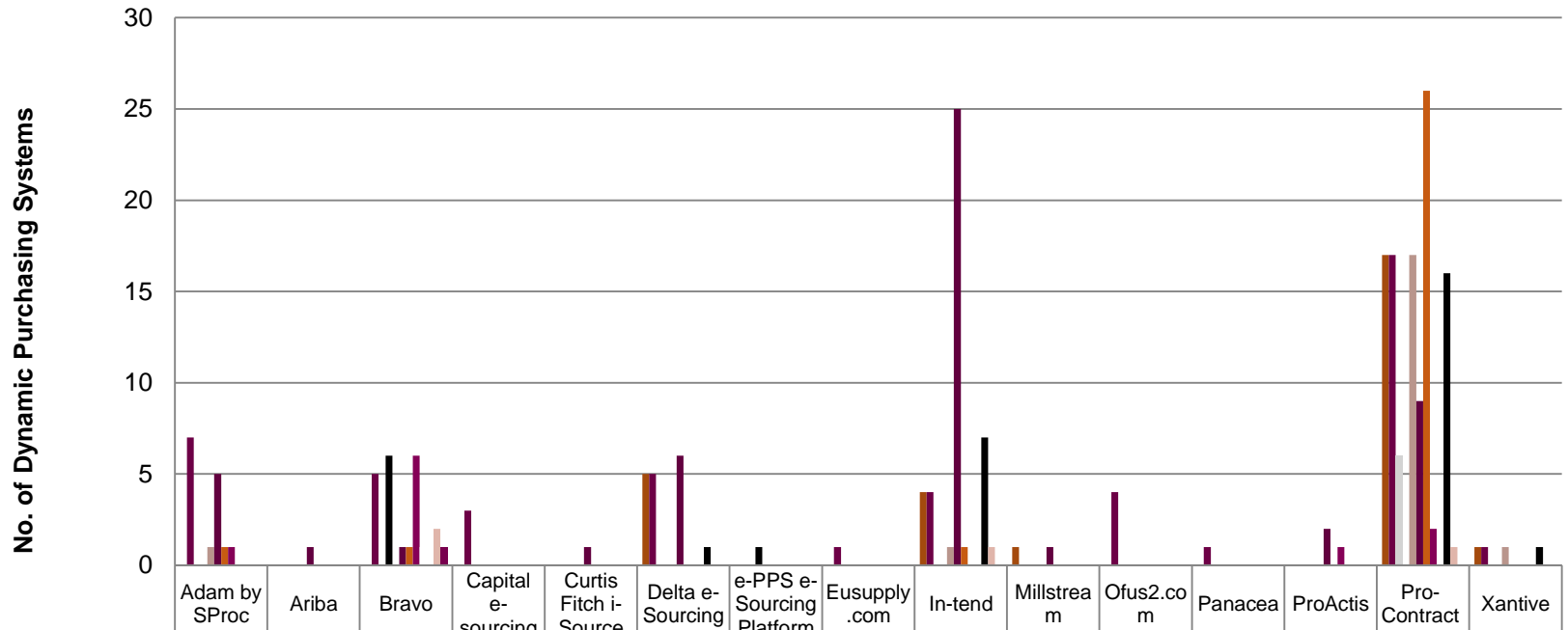


DPS Sourcing Platforms
