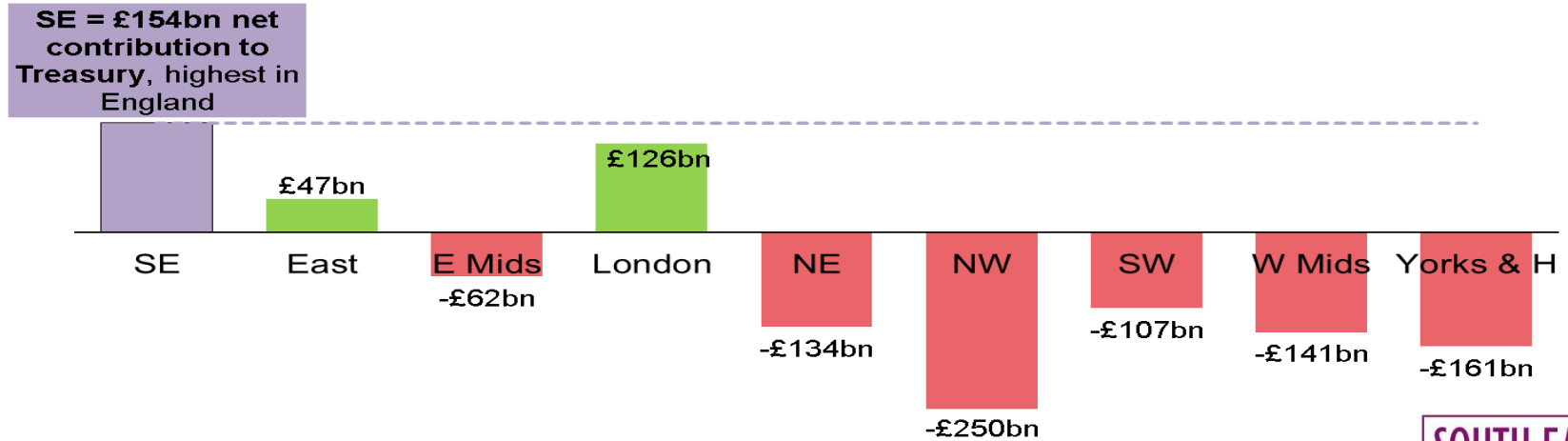

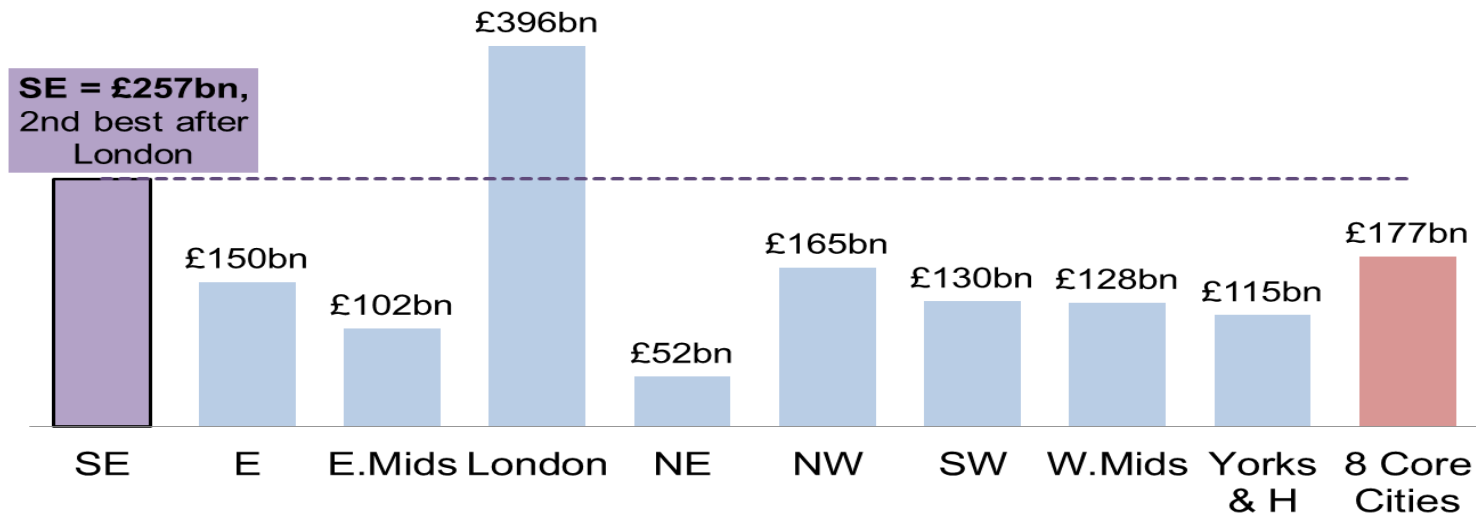
# Total residence-based contributions to UK public finances, 2000/01 – 2015/16

South East in strong second position after London in total GVA. Annual GVA growth per head fluctuates from year to year. Greater infrastructure investment could help us bridge the gap with London.

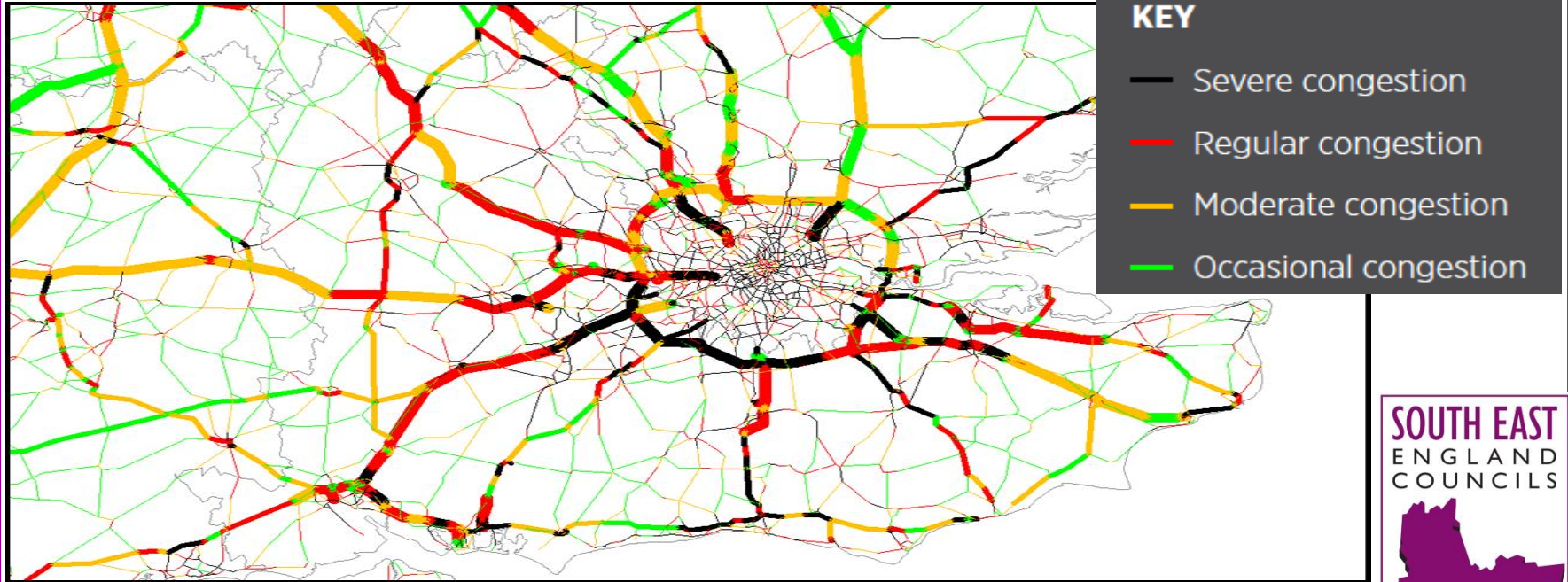

Volume to capacity ratio with RIS 1 investment – AM peak

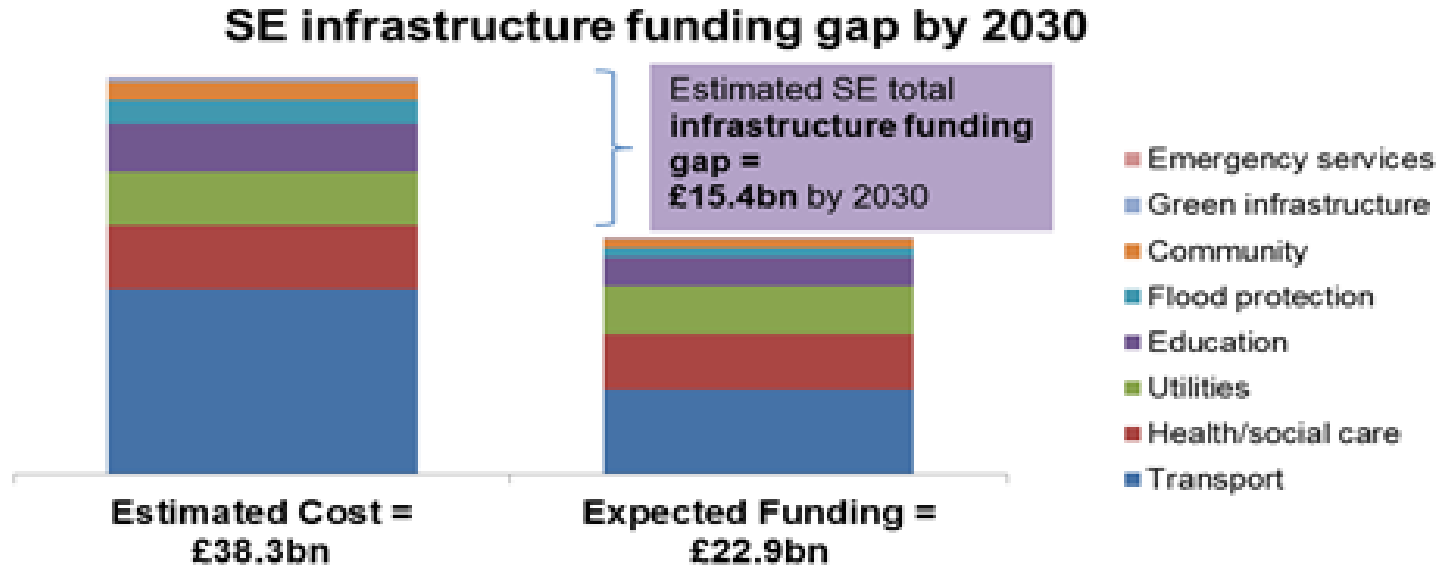

# £15.4bn SE infrastructure funding gap by 2030

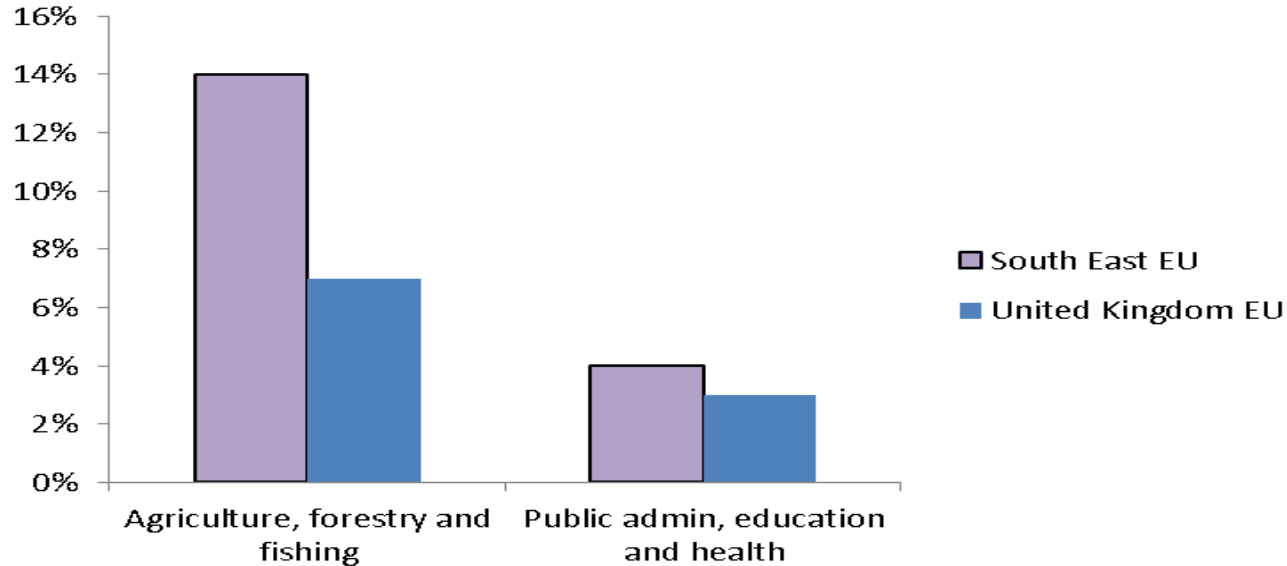


This will restrict South East economic growth and harm public services if not addressed.
