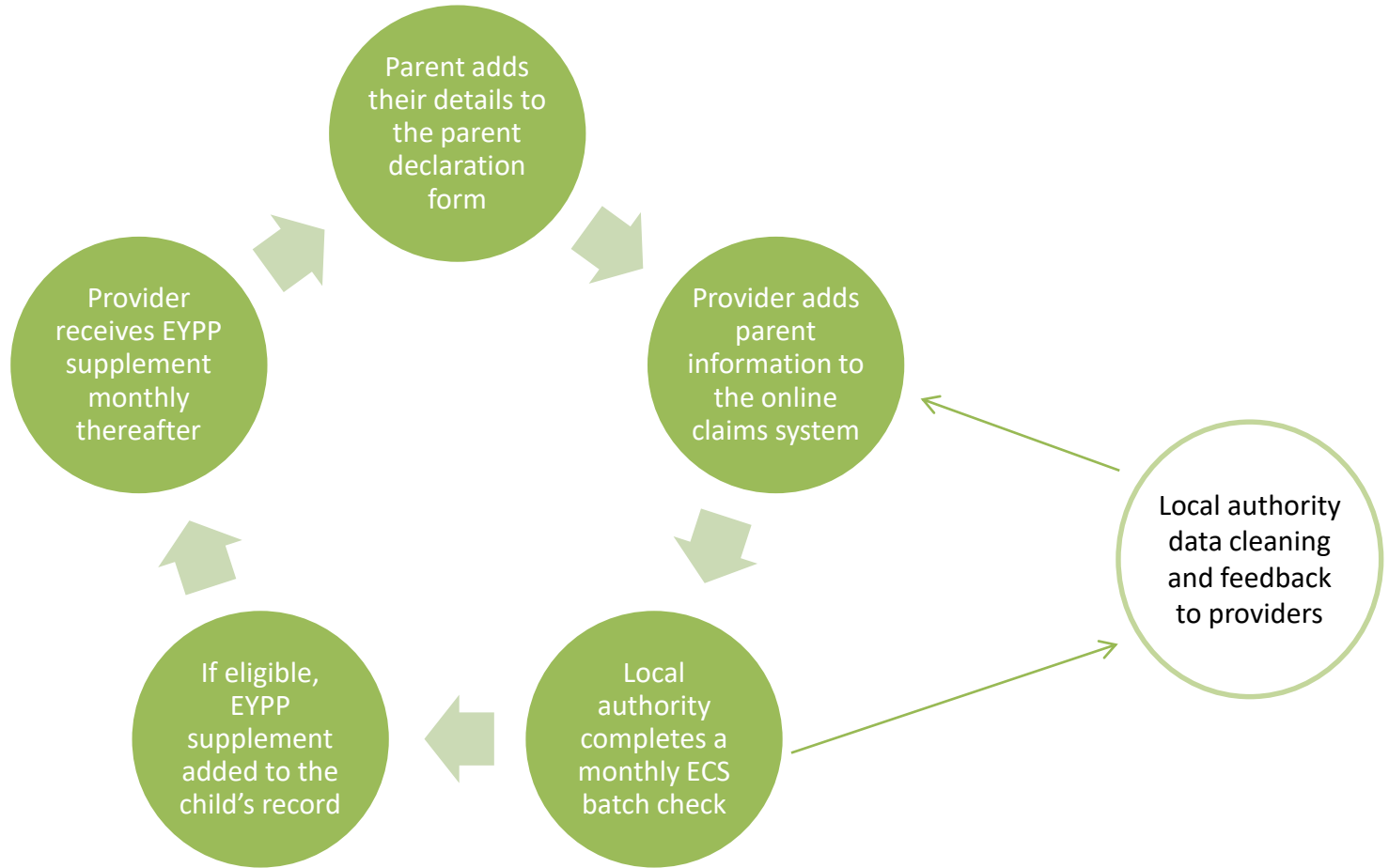

COMPARING DATA

How to determine if the number of children we are funding is a good representation of the total eligible?

- Confidence in providers gathering parent information
- High proportion of parent details included in ECS batch checks
- Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI)
- Number of 3 and 4 year olds residing in postcode areas within IDACI bands
- Take-up of other eligibility based entitlements - the 2 year old entitlement – recognising the variance in criteria
- Indications based on a proportion of children

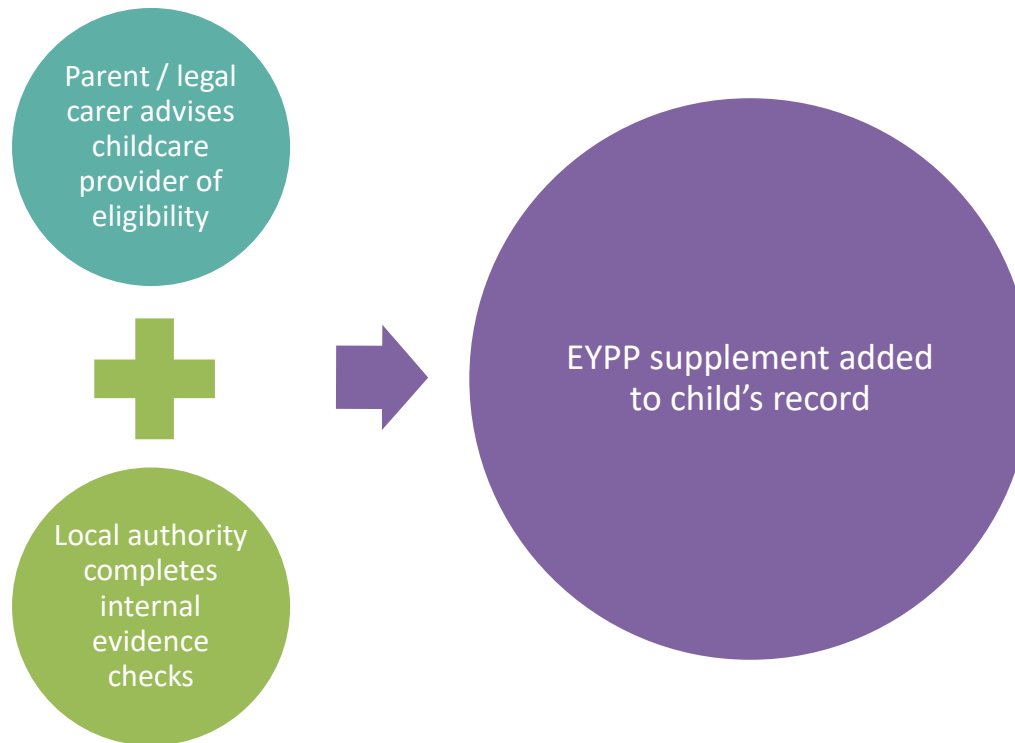

CHILDREN LOOKED AFTER BY THE LOCAL AUTHORITY

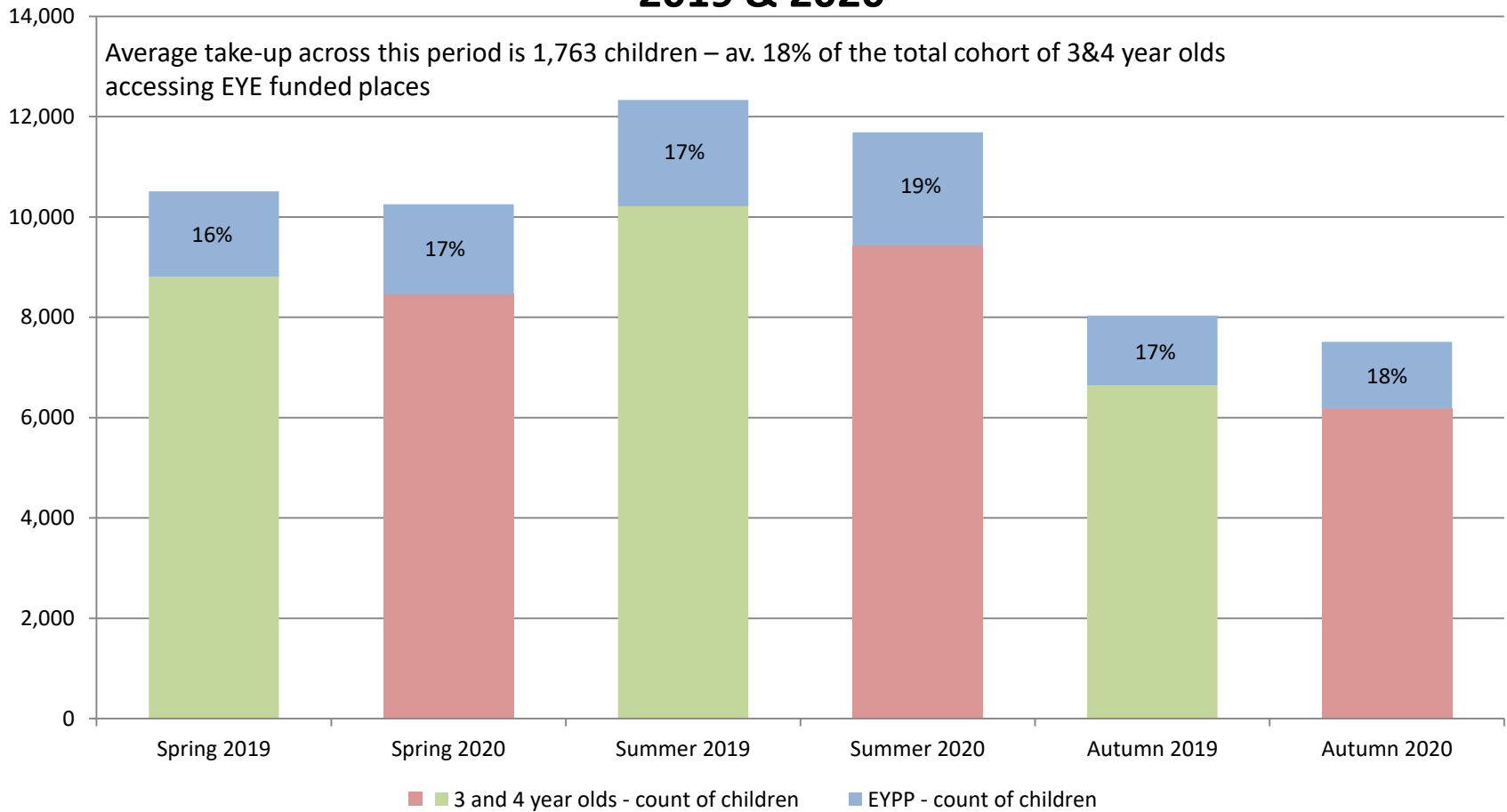
- Process led by The Virtual School
- EYPP allocation is linked to the e-PEP (Electronic Personal Education Plan)
- Providers are required to complete this document in conjunction with the Virtual School to show impact of this additional funding
- This process is separate to all other EYPP funding
- EYPP funding for Looked After Children must be spent to help meet the needs identified in the child's e-PEP

Local authority process for checking the eligibility of children who:

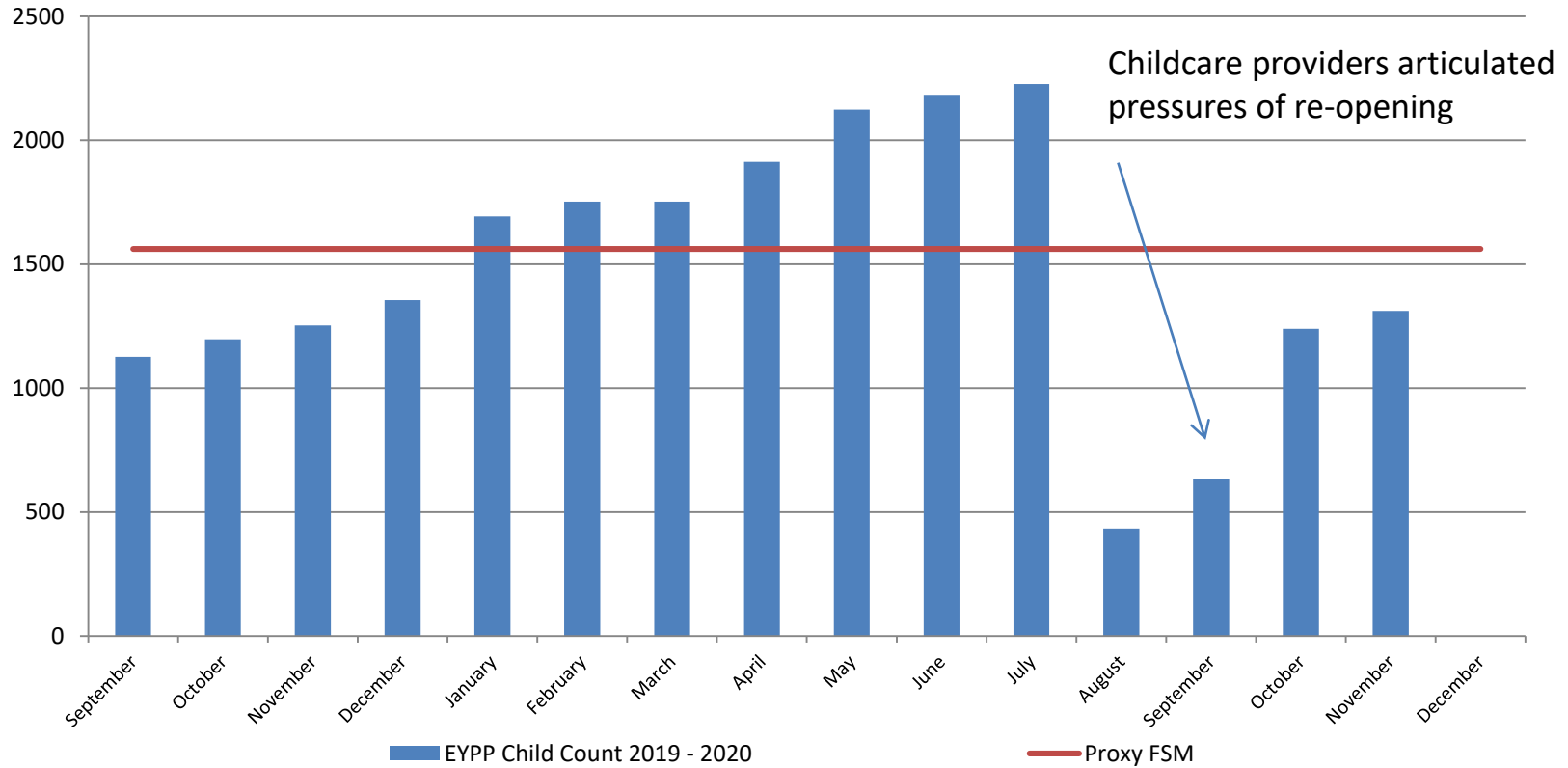
- have been adopted from local authority care
- have left care through a special guardianship order
- have left care through a child arrangements order
