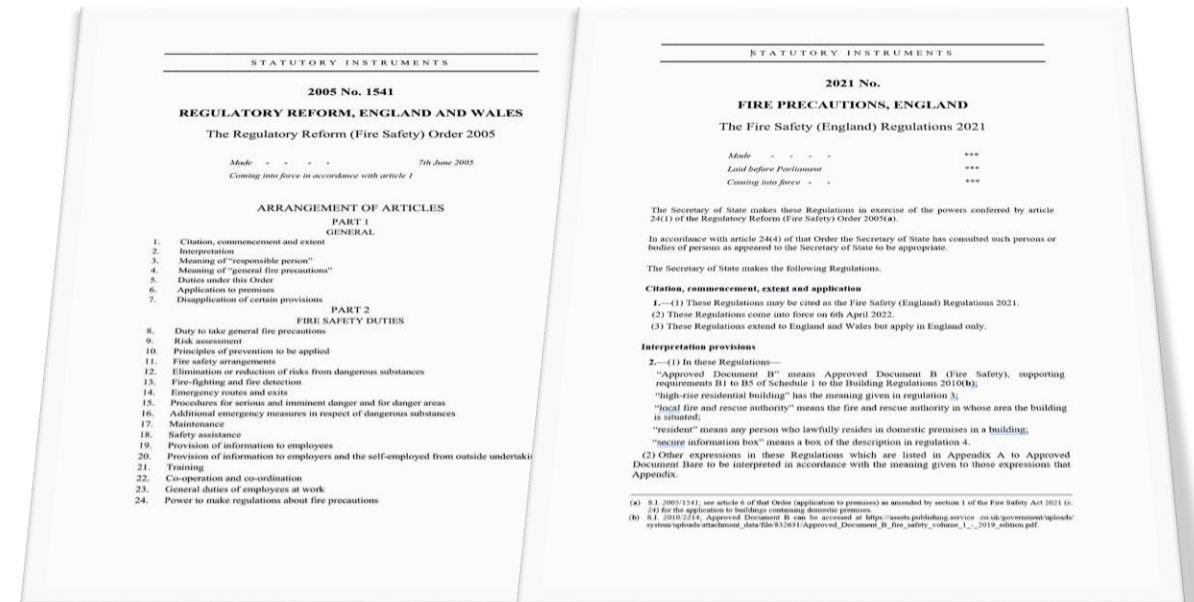

## Considerations

- They are part of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005.
- Prescriptive contrast against self-regulation.
- Overall enforcement approach is still based on what is proportionate.
- Enforcement threshold is defined for regulations

- Meet the requirements of the Grenfell Tower Inquiry Phase 1 recommendations
- Clear emphasis on dealing with operational elements of incidents in high rise residential buildings.
- Assist FRS to appropriately respond to incidents.
- Ensure RPs consider what is important in an emergency and be prepared.

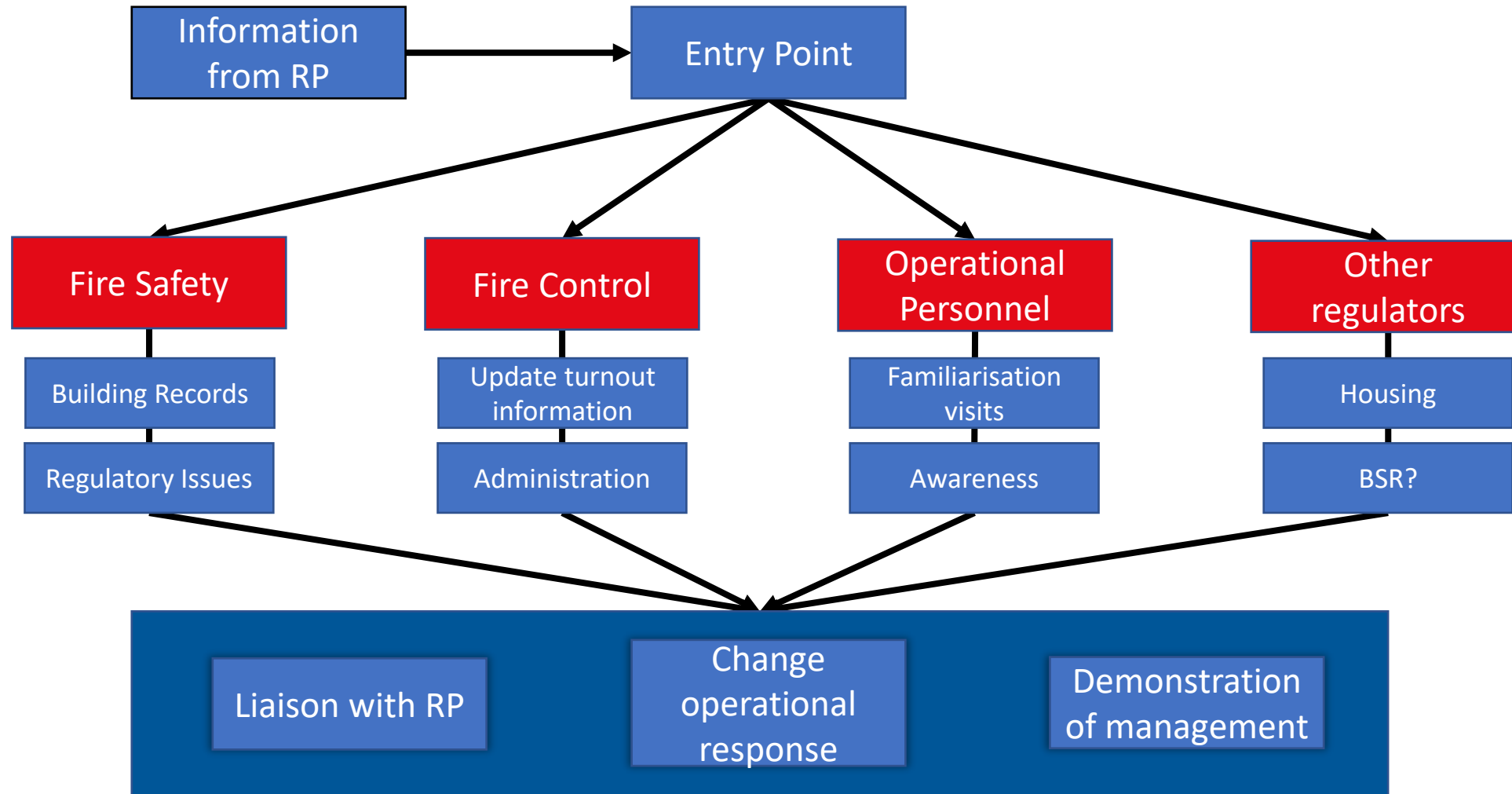

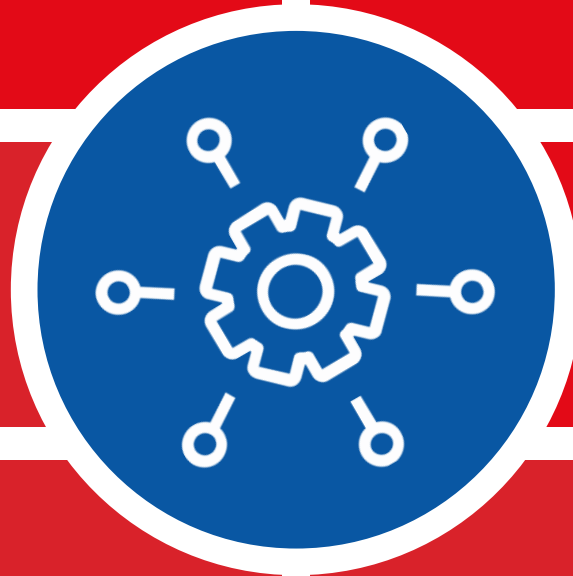
