New transport hub is making people's journeys so much better

The £6m development – brought about by the Greater Manchester Combined Authority (GMCA) – has revitalised the town centre and has resulted in an increase in footfall of between 8,000 to 10,000 per week.

The Interchange features a brand new bus station located directly alongside the Wythenshawe Town Centre tram stop, a Travelshop with high quality cycle parking facilities and ready access to town centre shops and facilities.

Bus operator Stagecoach has praised the new facility. They said:


