# WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT....

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64% of care leavers said that they are in debt or their debt or their debt has increased. 45% are struggling to buy food and are having to choose between food and rent/bills.

76% said yes to having an impact of metal health

Many care leavers live independently and many of them do not receive any financial support from friends or family.



65% of young people said that the cost of living has significantly impacted them financially, mentally and emotionally.

## EXPERIENCES.....

"I'm worried & stressed, giving up on hobbies & interests, loosing motivation in general and feeling Its pointless to try and budget"

"I have to choose between heating and eating"

"Without the means to socialise we are left isolated and this effects our mental health and causes stress"

"Even with Universal credit, it's not enough to cover all expenses as gas and heating prices are increasing."



"how can we budget when there is not enough money to afford all essential items"

## ASK

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#### Access to Advice:

Tips on reducing heating, budgeting support, workers taking me shopping, helping with meal plans"

Prioritize financial well being as critical to care experienced young people and their futures

#### Crisis Support:

Leaving care teams and personal advisors. Pay point vouchers or crediting the utility accounts when we are running low, food parcels or supermarket vouchers

#### Best Practice:

Secure ring fenced money from your local authority's household support fund

Debt support:

How to reduce debts, payment plans

## OUR ASK.....

- Care Leavers Hub in every local authority
  - Coproduce your Hub with young people
  - Keep young people involved in the development of the facility, form a steering form
  - What physical spaces do you have that you could free up for this?
  - What businesses could support this?
  - Get it in the budget and keep resourcing it

  - North East Free Bus/metro








## OUR ASK.....

- Not just buses, trams, underground etc.
  - For Local Authorities to work with their travel providers
  - May need a regional approach, which could be part of a regional care leavers' offer
