BRAVE - Evolution

- Building upon our foundations - using M.E.A.M. Approach / Framework
- Three tracks to develop
 - Early Identification and Prevention – Talk Community - + 56 days - UPstream
 - Support - Intensive (long-term / complex multiple disadvantages) – T.A.I.
 - Support – Light (short term / single issue disadvantage) – Business as normal
- Systems development
 - Data – capture and use, information sharing
 - Multi agency / sector collaboration and delivery
 - Pooled / Shared / co-located resources
 - Training – TIA, Stress management, H&S and risk assessment

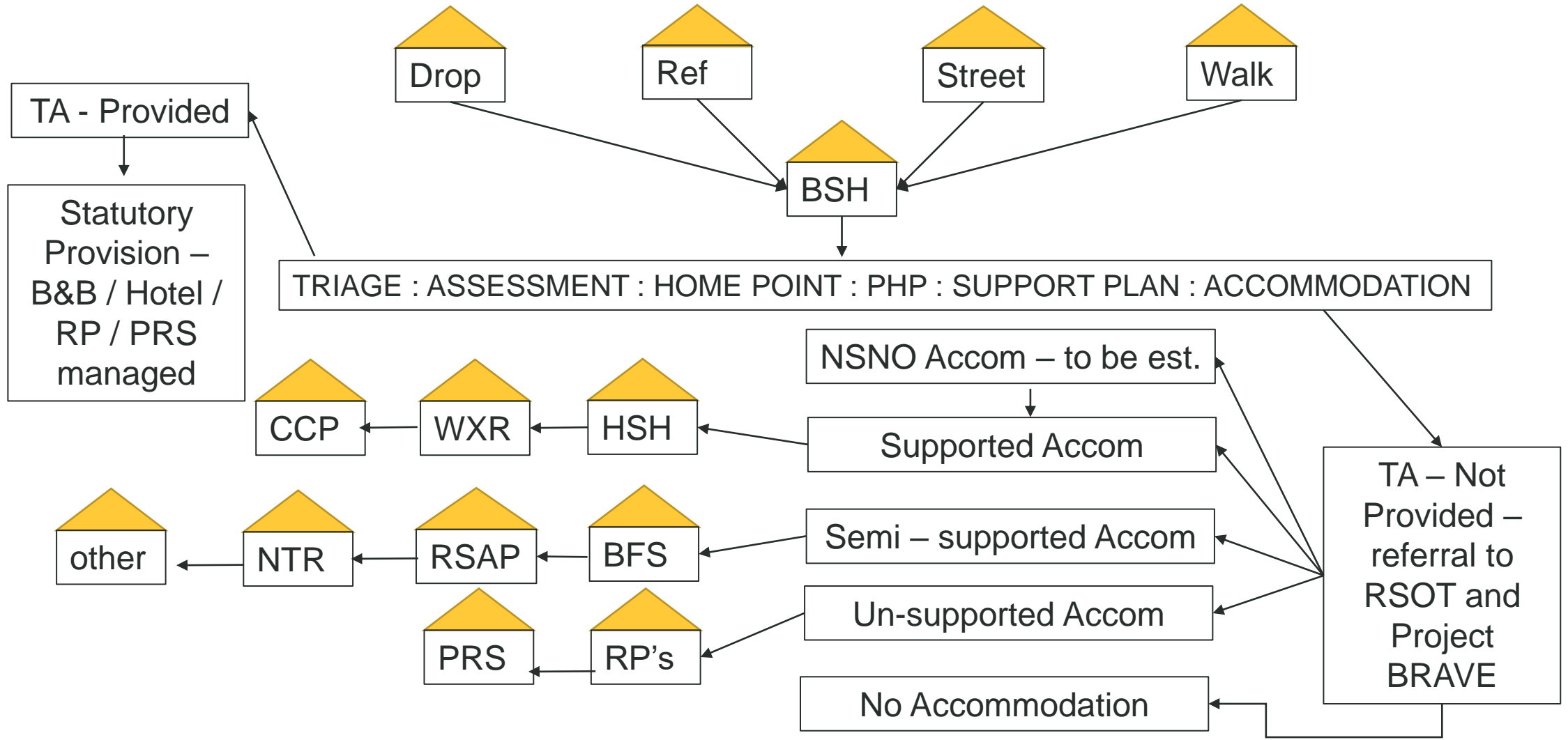
BRAVE – Governance and Delivery

- BRAVE – Team Around Individual / BTC - BRONZE

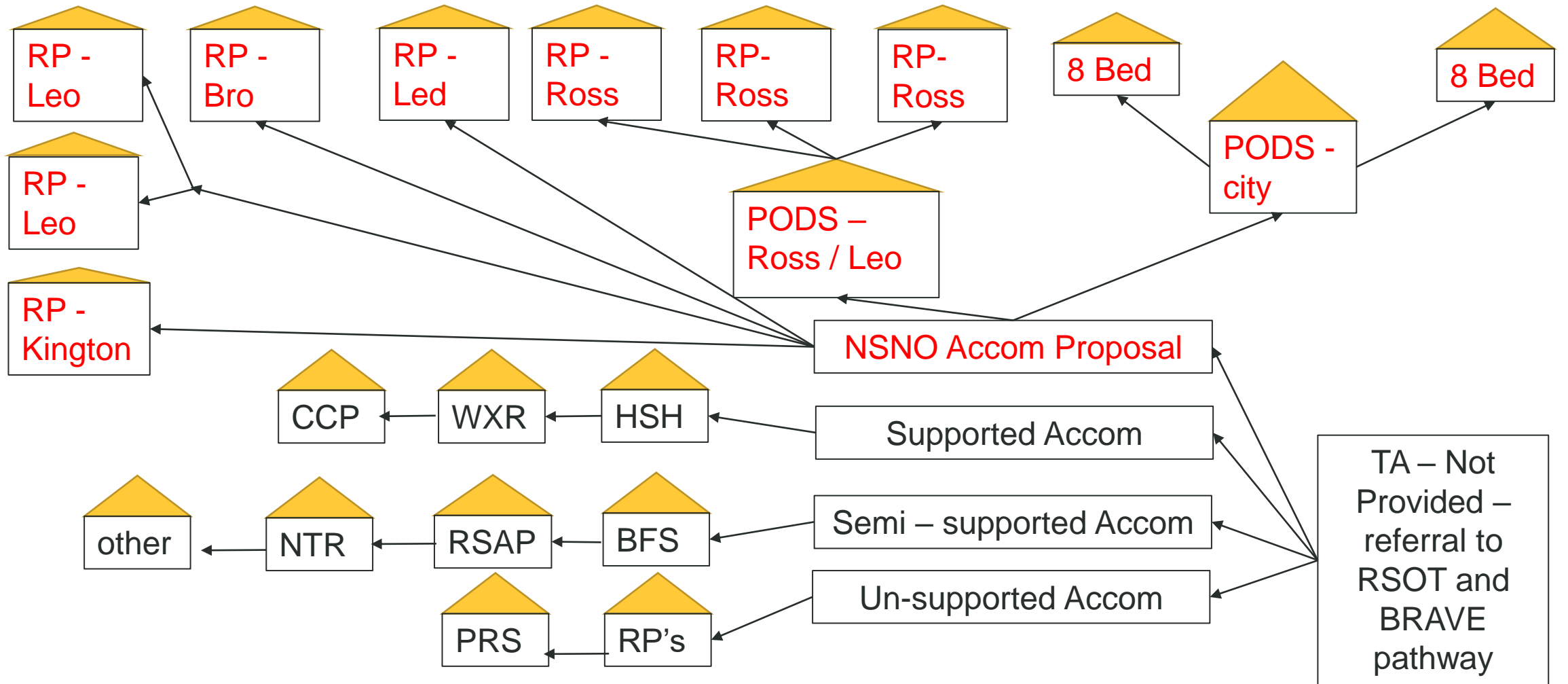
