Local Authorities involved	Amount Granted	Project Activity
Bournemouth Borough Council	£25,000	Integration of data across the council, health and range of partner agencies working together to support Troubled Families – to improve data quality and provide insight to inform decision making.
Wigan Metropolitan Borough Council	£25,000	To develop a Single View of a Child's Record to support integrated working across partners, reducing duplication and improving outcomes.
Northumberland Council	£25,000	To support the development of cloud based Public health portal including: enabling real time data, integration with other data sets, e.g. Lower Super Output Areas and ward levels.
Tunbridge Wells Borough Council, all Kent districts and Medway Council	£40,000	To develop and implement a new online homeless triage process including an online housing application pre-assessment form, a redesigned simpler version of current online application form.
London Borough of Bexley	£25,000	To develop a data analytics system to link the existing Employment and Skills Management Information (MI) system, Housing and the Troubled Families data to facilitate early intervention to tackle financial exclusion.
Cambridgeshire County Council & Peterborough City Council	£40,000	To ensure that customers/clients have access to consistent information / advice or access to services from a range of 'front doors' that will enable them to resolve their needs, delivering the concept of 'No Wrong Place' – based on developing a shared data standard across the partners and a model for feeding data to a range of partners.
Thurrock Council	£25,000	Integration of various sources of health and social care data in order to maintain a healthy population.
East Sussex County Council	£25,000	Data matching and analytical tools for identifying and supporting vulnerable families and children.

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Adur & Worthing Council and West Sussex County Council	£39,760	Digitalising existing <i>Going local</i> community referral service for health & well-being – creating a suite of digital services and apps.
London Borough of Camden	£25,000	Integration of data sets from different partners supporting Troubled Families to better facilitate and evaluate multi-agency working.
Dorset County Council	£25,000	Develop a business intelligence digital dashboard to deliver better targeted preventative services based on predicative data to support children.
London Borough Of Hounslow	£25,000	Develop a multi-agency intelligence tool for identifying the top 20 adults with complex needs and chaotic lives.
Cumbria County Council	£25,000	To implement 'live' integration of GP and LA social care record to providing access (based on consent) to social care and health staff.
North Somerset Council	£25,000	To create data analytic tools enabling early identification of those families most likely to benefit from intervention.
Leeds City Council and Calderdale Council	£40,000	To define the Open data standards – underpinning an open platform for the integration of health and social care. This will support the development of a dataset that can be used to develop new applications.
Worcestershire County Council	£25,000	Creation of information sharing platform for all the different organisations involved in safeguarding children.
