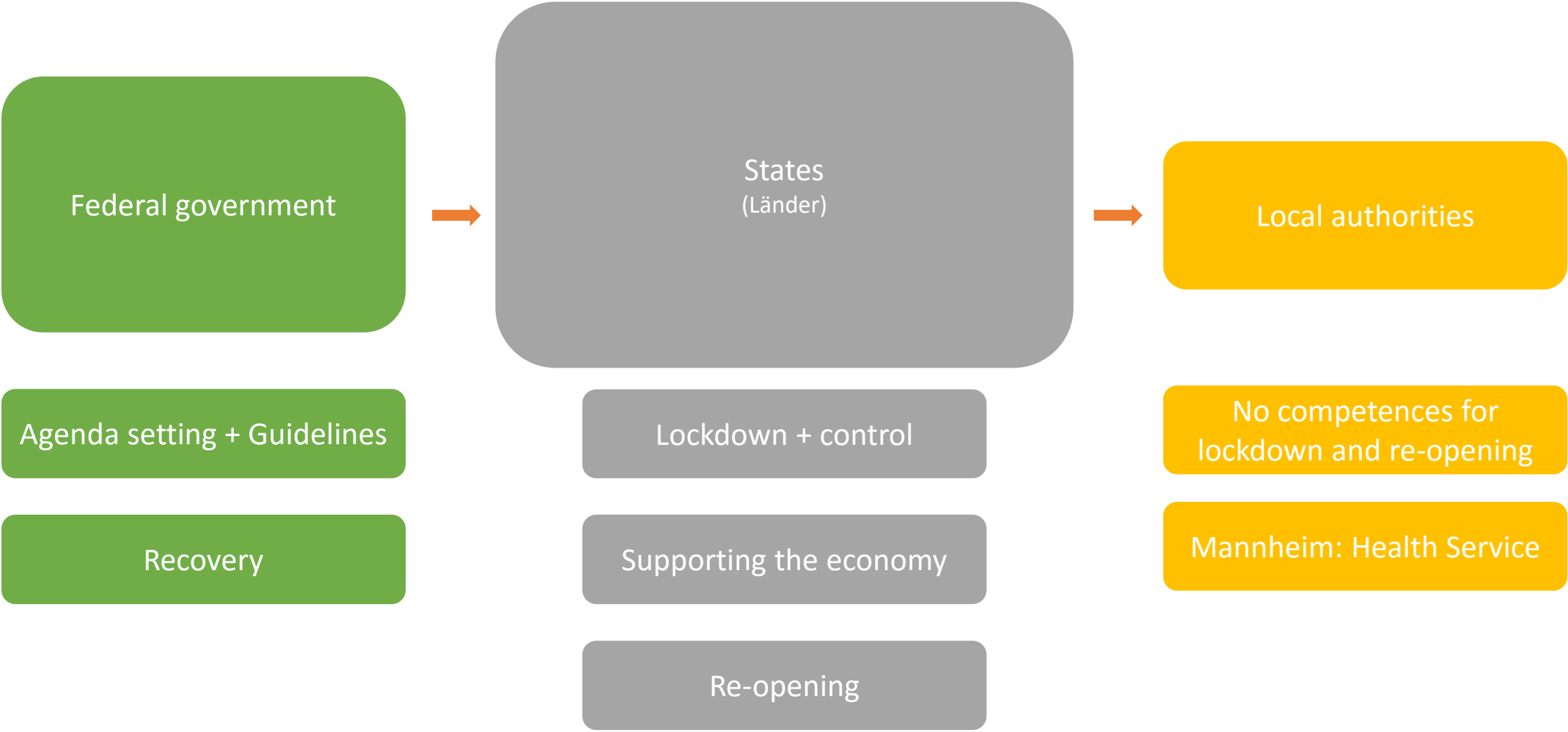

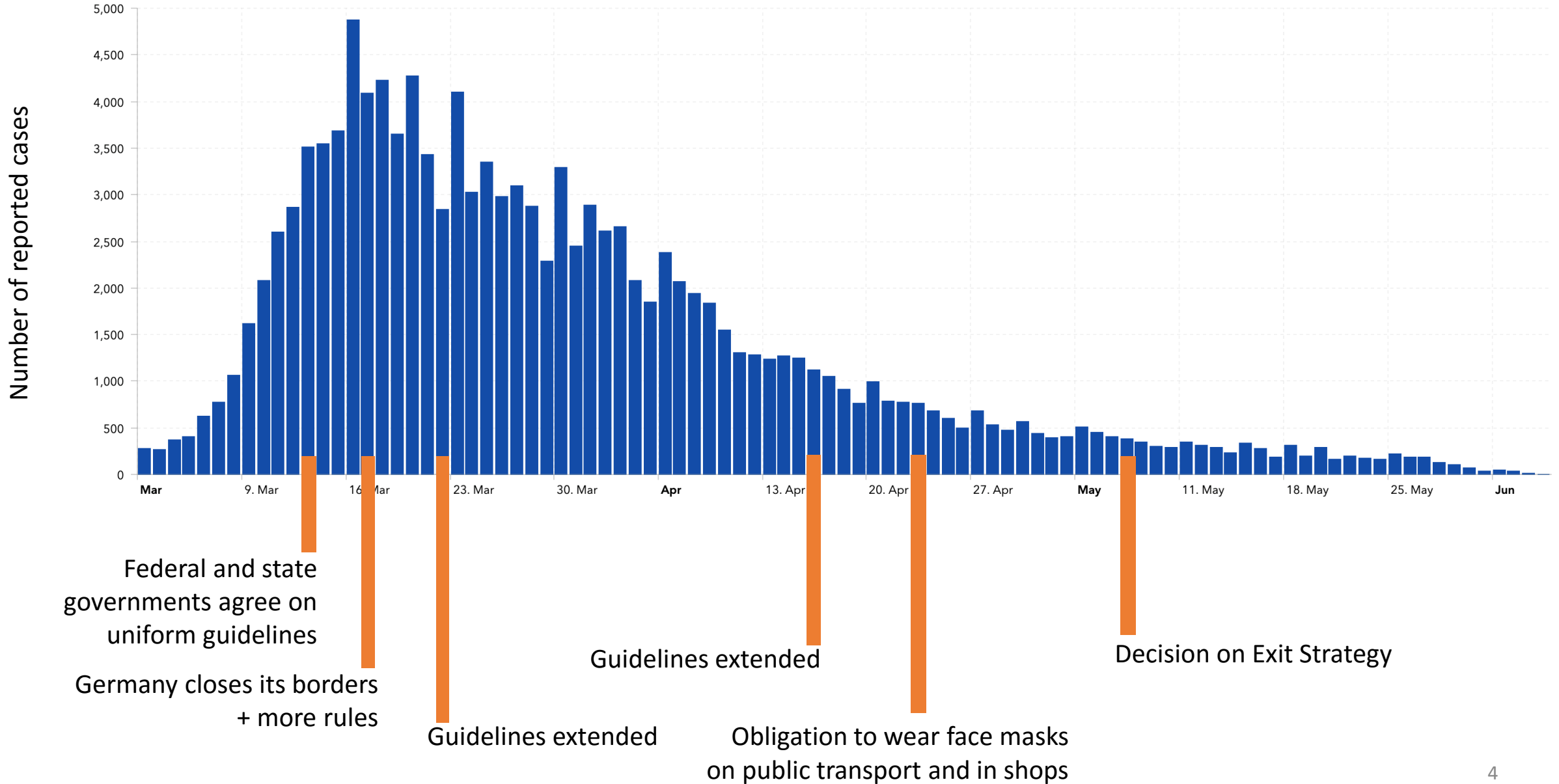
Recovered

Death rate: 4,7%

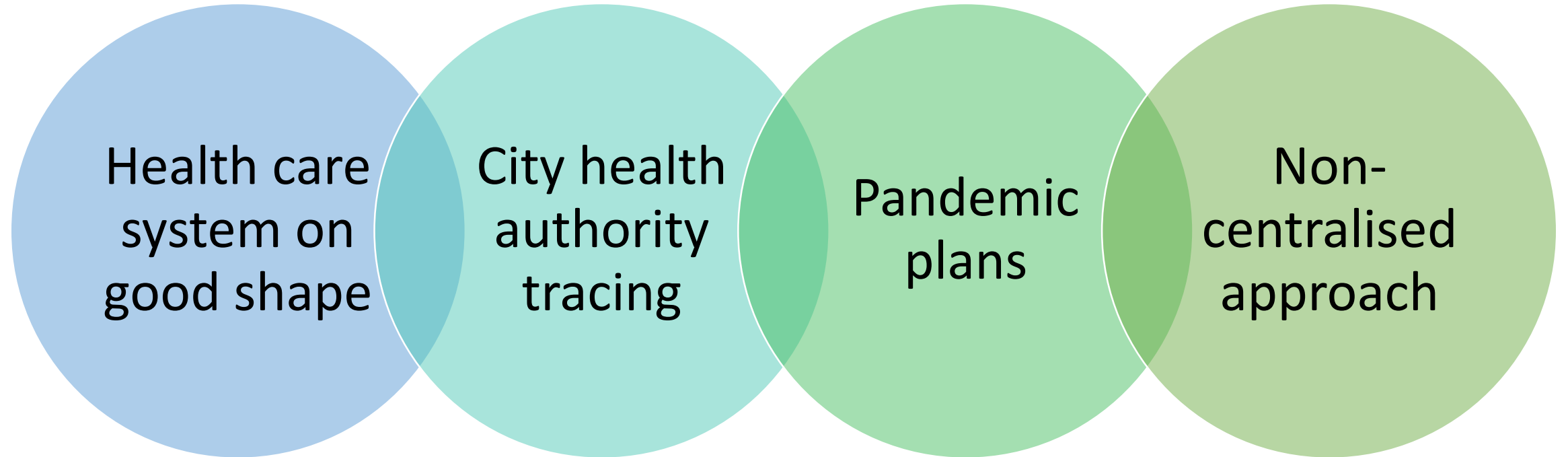
Responsibilities for pandemic control in the federal state



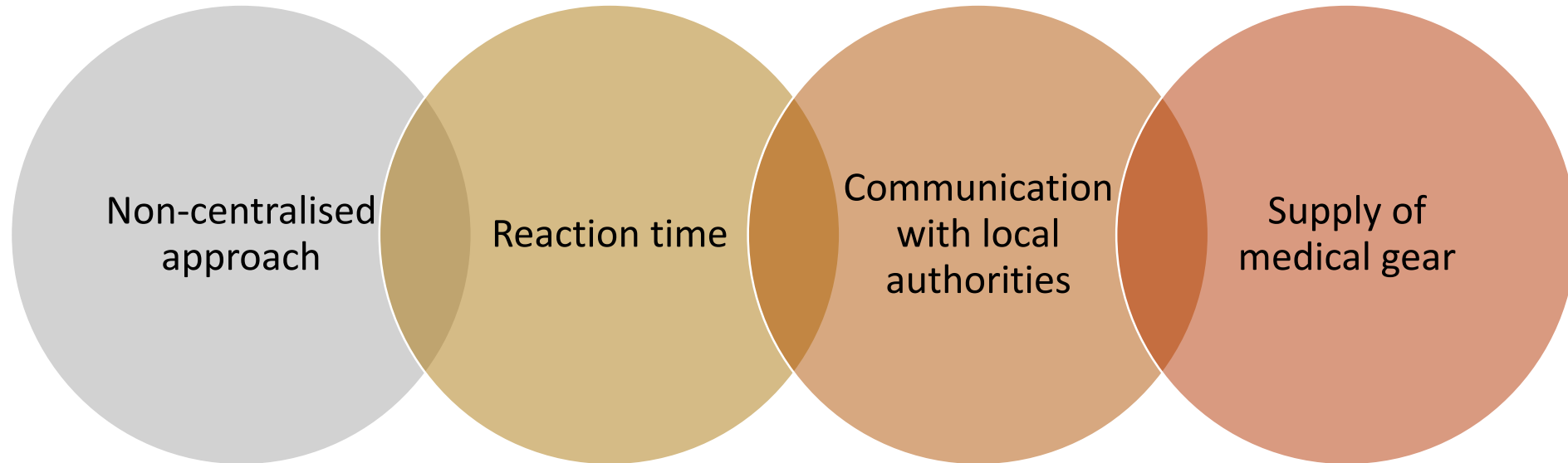

In general

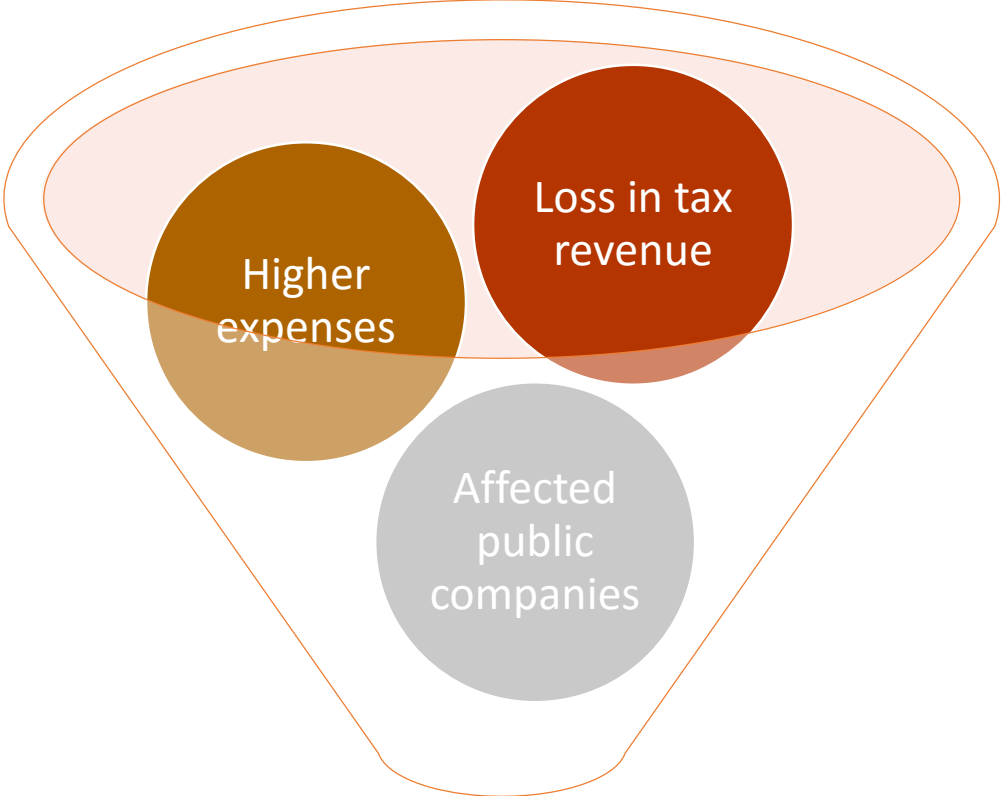
- Be coherent
