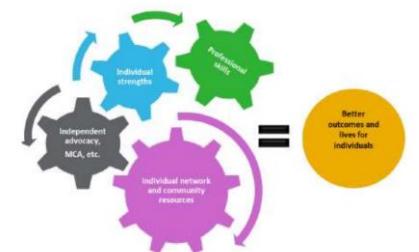

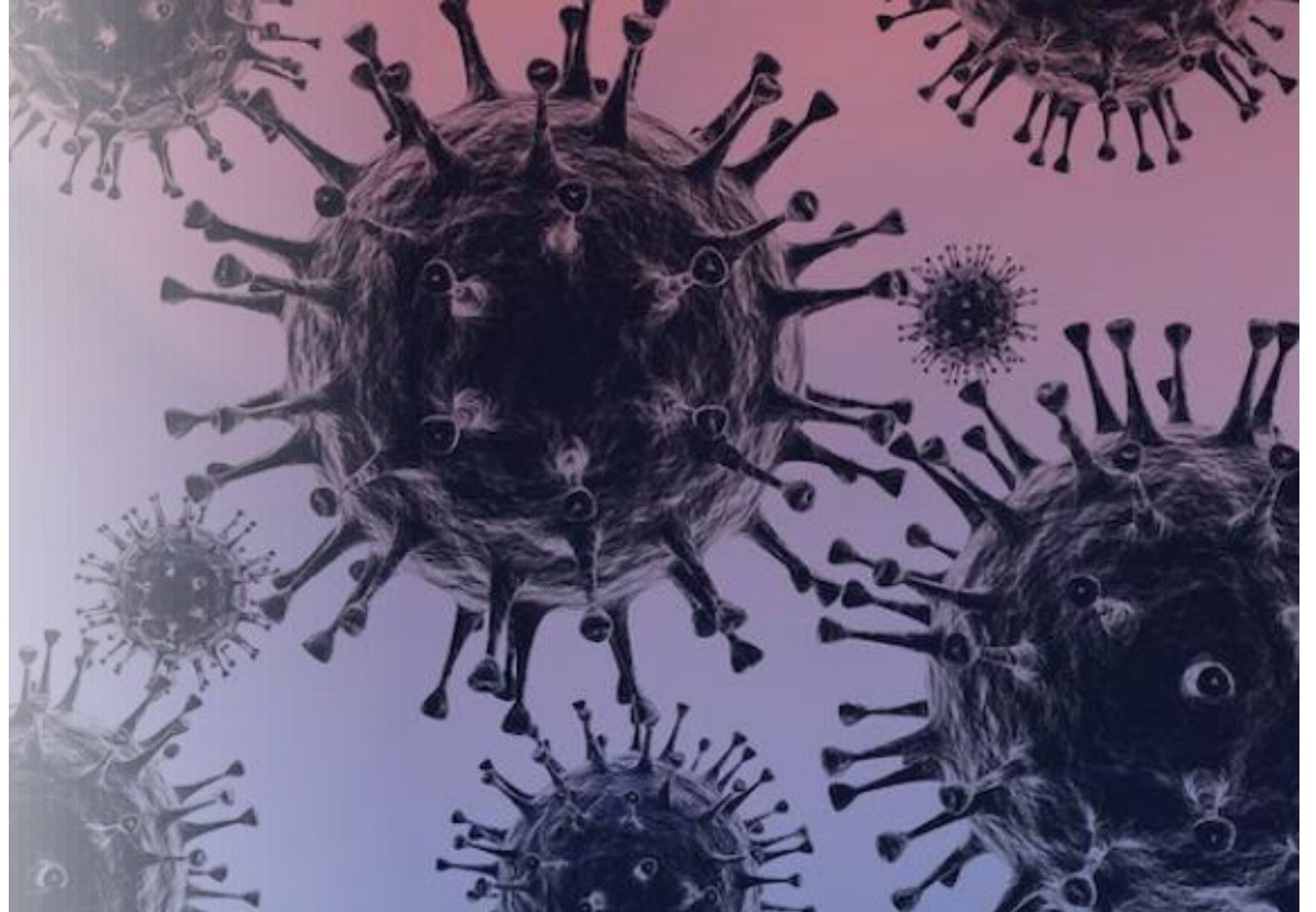
COVID-19 adult safeguarding insight project: findings and discussion
