ESHO: What we set out to do and why

- Engage and support economically inactive people in the County, understand their needs better, and help go into/back into employment, education and training or volunteering.
- Gloucestershire County Council bridged the gap between the GEM Project and funding from the Districts' UK Shared Prosperity Fund (UKSPF) in March 2024 by providing £600k of funding.
- Each of the six Gloucestershire Districts has provided UKSPF funding.








Referrals



- Total Referrals 313 (to 19th October 2023)
- 63% declared a disability or health condition
- 35% do not claim any benefit
- 47% claim Universal Credit
- 11% claim Employment and Support Allowance
- 27% are from ethnic minorities
- 68% referrals come through partner organisations and 18% through E & S Hub triage

Gloucestershire Growth Hub Network

- GFirst Local Enterprise Partnership & University of Gloucestershire 3 tiers of access
- EU ERDF capital funding supported the creation of the hub workpaces
- UKSPF revenue funding needed to continue Growth Hub Network core costs from April 2023 - March 2025
- All Gloucestershire Districts worked together to agree £79,000 from UKSPF UKSPF Investment Plan amendment & formal reporting
- In FoDDC, Gfirst LEP had to submit an EOI and Cabinet approval was required to support the UKSPF Investment Plan amendment
