Why it's time to act on housing...

 56% - For 2023/24, only just over half of councils are able to take a positive investment strategy for housing and accommodation

• £1.4bn – Estimated cost to the NHS of poor housing

Why it's time to act on housing...

- 98% of Directors say more accessible and adaptable homes would improve outcomes in their area
- 90% of Directors say more Shared Lives housing would improve outcomes in their area
- 70% of Directors say more supported housing in their area would save them money on ASC, enabling them to reinvest
